## What all Badges those Badges mean to parents

The badges you see on the front of a Scout's uniform stand for everything from **confidence**, **belonging** and **social skills** to **leadership**, **citizenship** and the **value of family**. Basically, they're symbols of a good kid having a lot of fun.

For more than 100 years, the Scouting program has been teaching boys to appreciate family, friends and most importantly, themselves. They go on **field trips**, **learn about science and the outdoors**, **build things** and **make new friends**. No other program gives kids the opportunity to participate in as many **fun**, **positive learning experiences** as Scouting.

Cub Scouting is a year-round family program designed for boys who are at least five years old and in kindergarten through fifth grade, and not older than 10 years of age. Each Scout is part of a den of 6-8 boys that meets a few times a month. Membership is a prorated national fee of \$15 per year. Cub Scouts are also encouraged to subscribe to Boys' Life magazine with a one-year subscription cost of \$12. Scouting is **open to every boy**, regardless of their ability to pay membership costs. **You can join at any time**.
